Section A: ES WSQ WPLN Assessments					
Q1	How do I register for the WPLN assessments?				
A	Registration for the WPLN assessments is available online at www.wsg.gov.sg/ces.html or by calling the Centre for Employability Skills (CES) at 6883 5885.				
Q2	Which assessment/s should I register for?				
A	<p>According to CEA's requirement, Statement of Attainment (SOA) level 5 and above for the WPLN assessments in these 5 skills (Reading, Listening, Speaking, Writing and Numeracy) will be recognised in lieu of 4 GCE "O" level passes, you would need to take all of the following 5 assessments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reading - Listening - Speaking - Writing - Numeracy 				
Q3	How much does the WPLN assessments cost?				
A	Each assessment is \$4.30 (inclusive of GST) for Singaporeans and Permanent Residents (PRs). For non-Singaporeans and non-PRs, it is \$43.00 (inclusive of GST) for each assessment.				
Q4	Where can I take the WPLN assessments?				
A	Besides the Centre for Employability Skills, you may sign up for the assessments at any of the WPLN Approved Training Organisations (ATOs).

Q5 What should I do if I want to reschedule my assessment date?

A Rescheduling of assessment dates should be done by calling the Centre for Employability Skills or the WPLN ATO which you have signed up at, at least 5 working days before the scheduled assessment date.

Q6 Can I retake the test if I fail to obtain SOA level 5?

A Yes, you may. However, there is a three-month lockout period before you can take the same assessment again.

If you wish to retake the assessment within the lock-out period, you will be required to pay the assessment fee at full cost, i.e. \$43.00 (inclusive of GST) per assessment. Alternatively, you can consider signing up for the respective WPLN course to improve your literacy and numeracy competency before you attempt the assessment again. Trainees who have successfully completed the WPLN course are exempted from the three-month lockout period and will be enrolled for the assessments immediately.

Section B: WPLN Course

Q7 Which WPLN course should I sign up?

A Dependent on your needs and your training recommendation after the assessment, you can sign up for any of the following WPLN courses. There are 3 training pathways available for Workplace Literacy (WPL) and 1 training pathway for Workplace Numeracy (WPN). All courses have 3 levels - "Beginner", "Intermediate" and "Advanced".

A	The course fee varies depending on the course and the ATO you choose.
